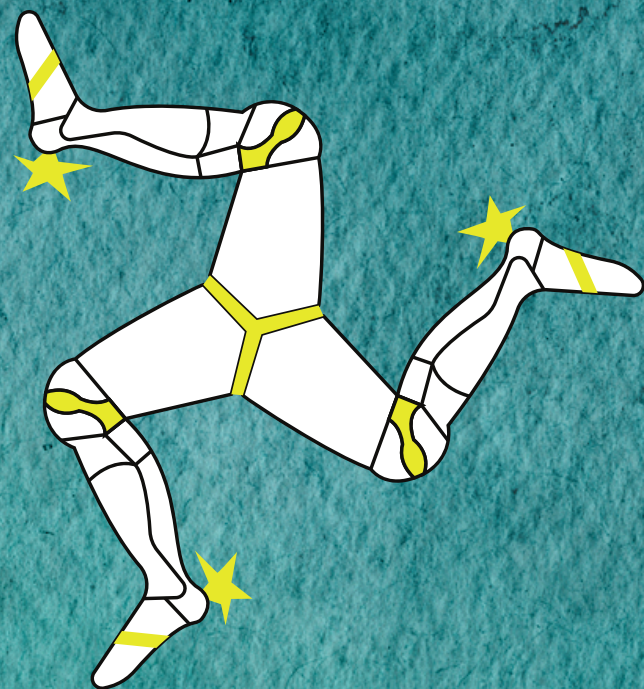

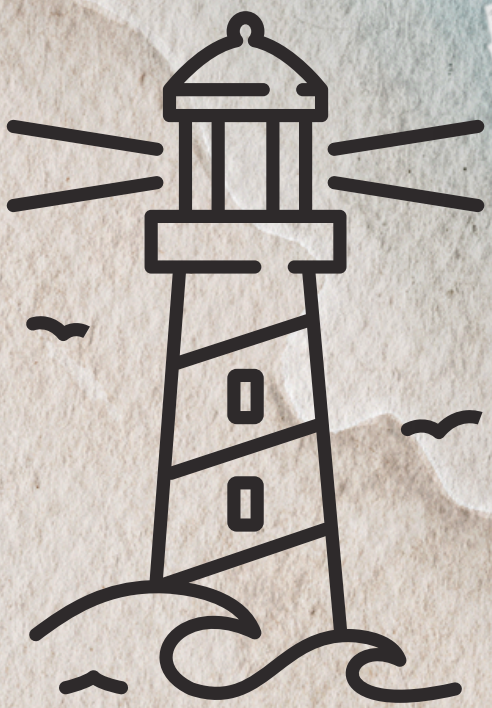
Literacy
