The Online Safety Centre has loads of really useful information, e.g. how to set up parental controls on different devices or online.


When you click on the Safety Hub you will see the latest notifications.



Launch the app and then type Braddan School. Enter the parent code 7440 or the pupil code 9342. Using the pupil code when primary school aged children are accessing the app is essential as the

parent code enables information relevant to young adults to be available for browsing too.



Enabling notifications ensures that you stay fully informed of the latest advice and information. It is all easily available on your phone or tablet on the app. You can download the app on all of your electronic devices and use the same codes.
