We expect adults to ...

1. Be calm.
2. Be emotionally consistent.
3. Be positive.
4. To have a shared responsibility for behaviour.
5. Start and end the day on a positive.

Our school expectations are...

1. Be safe.
2. Be respectful.
3. Be ready.

Recognition of Effort

1. Putting others before yourself.
2. Celebrating others.

This is celebrated by a value certificate or sticker.

Acknowledgement of recognition in class.

Children recognise school values and reward each other.

Our Value Message;

We have positive relationships where all are valued.

Stepped sanctions...

1. Non verbal reminder.
 2. Verbal reminder (30 sec script).
 3. Moved within the classroom (review).
 4. Calm corner - offer distractions.
 5. Adults offer empathy not a solution.
- (Parents informed - phone call home before the end of the day)**

Micro-script - 30 sec

I've noticed that ... (identify behaviour).
Remember our rule is
At the moment you are choosing not to
Remember when (remind of a positive behaviour).
I know that you can do better.
Let's get back to learning.

Praise when behaviour is corrected and effort made.

Restorative Questions using the visual book (child appropriate)

What happened?
What were you thinking or feeling?
How have you been feeling since it happened?
Who was affected?
How can we make this better?

When the adults change, everything changes.
