Parent Information Letter Summer 2023 Year 5

Summer at last! We are hoping for good weather and lots of opportunities for outdoor learning.

We are using our School Values in class:

Show Respect Learn Together Try Your Best

Our **metacognition** curriculum offers a variety of skills based learning experiences for the children to understand how to become emotionally literate and support their personal learning journey.

We believe it is essential to develop our students' capabilities by encouraging them to follow the school values.

We have lessons that encourage children to consider their social, emotional, physical and moral wellbeing, and to raise awareness and tolerance of different beliefs and cultures. Maths is taught by using the Teaching for Mathematical Understanding curriculum. This term we are focusing on our multiplication and division skills by learning to multiply and divide bigger numbers, and using fractions, decimals and percentages.

English - Our novel and writing focus will be Holes by Louis Sachar. We will be using this novel to focus our reading comprehension and writing skills. We have guided reading sessions each week to develop our reading and comprehension skills. Our weekly extended creative writing session is very popular and will continue this term. Spelling and grammar sessions will focus on pronouns, word families and subordinate clauses. We will also have handwriting sessions.



This term our topic is **Earth Matters**. This is a geography and sciencebased topic, with lots of other subjects included. We have had lots of discussion about what interests us, and our activities are based on the interests of the class.



PE is run by MSR on Monday mornings. This term the focus will be Cricket. **Please make sure that your child has the appropriate kit in for PE**. Earrings need to be taken out for each PE session.

Forest School - Year 5 will be taking part in Forest School each Thursday afternoon. Please make sure they have appropriate Forest School kit on that day, please ensure that you have all the correct kit.

Personal, Social Health Education - Year 5 will be receiving Jigsaw as part of their PSHE education this year. This term we are focusing on Healthy Me.

Geography

In Geography we will be studying various aspects of physical geography around the Earth, including the water cycle, rivers and coasts, and climate zones.

ICT - We will be using ICT as much as we can to enhance our learning within the classroom. In lessons we will be learning about e-safety and designing using Sketchup.
