Phonics

We will be developing our confidence blending words using all of the phonemes that we have learned so far this year. Literacy

This half term we will be doing lots of talking and listening activities. We will sequence stories and events using pictures, story maps and role-play (acting out the story or imaging we are characters from stories). We will enjoy reading fiction and non-fiction books related to our topic. We will use technology to create a speaking book as a class. We will focus on labelling pictures and writing simple sentences, e.g. This is a red fox. It has 4 legs.
