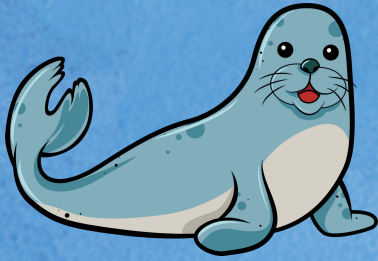
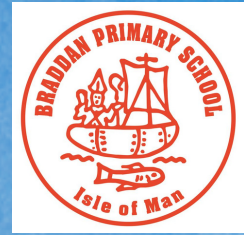

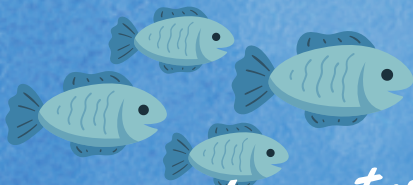

Curriculum information

In our Seal classroom, we have started our topic of 'spies'.

ENGLISH

This term, the Seals will compose stories and poems, sharing them orally - practising using intonation, volume, and expression. They will write dialogue with speech marks and write some great spy stories, with mysterious characters.

MATHS

It's all about numbers to 100 and then building to numbers to 1000 this half term. We will use number-lines and part-whole diagrams to partition numbers into place values.



SCIENCE

Humans and other animals:

We will be investigating life processes, such as nutrition, movement, growth and reproduction. We will carry out pattern seeking experiments that allow us to consider how exercise affects our bodies. Our spies will also be looking at the best materials for their missions...

OUTDOOR LEARNING

Our challenge is to build a stand-alone tent using a timber hitch and then creating a bird's nest by weaving.



GEOGRAPHY

The spies will be looking for physical features of hidden lairs and how humans have changed landscapes. We will use atlases, globes and apps to find key locations and describe how places could be changed to suit our purposes.

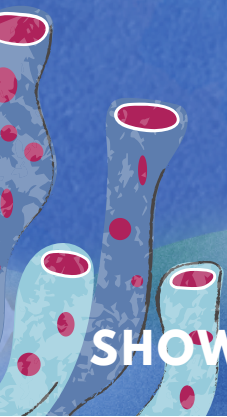


ART
