We will be finding out about mountains near and far, learning how they are created, how their features shape over time, and their climate and weather.

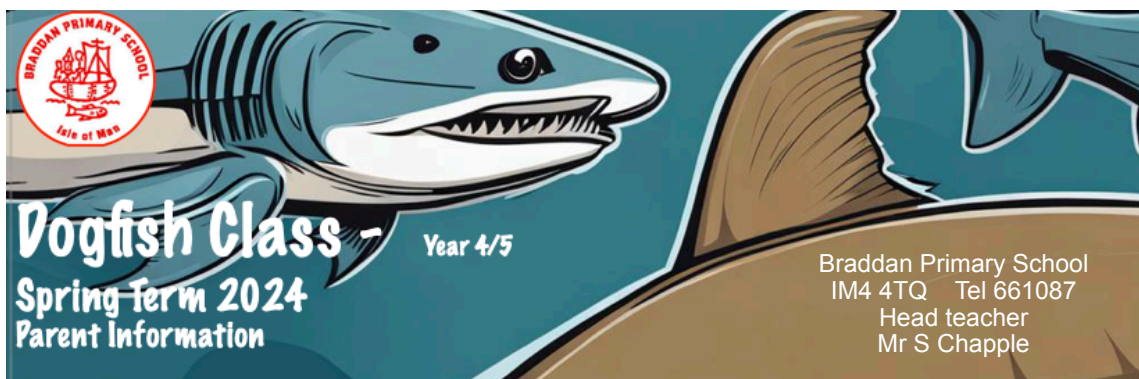
HOME LEARNING

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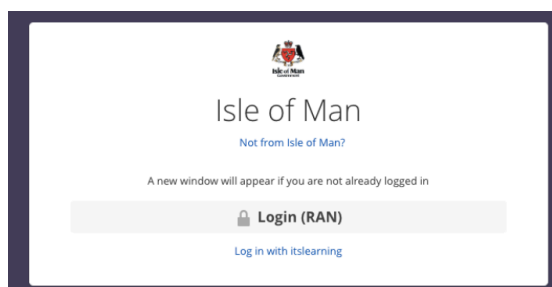
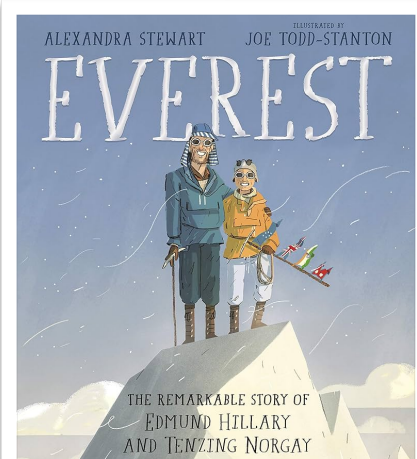
LITERACY

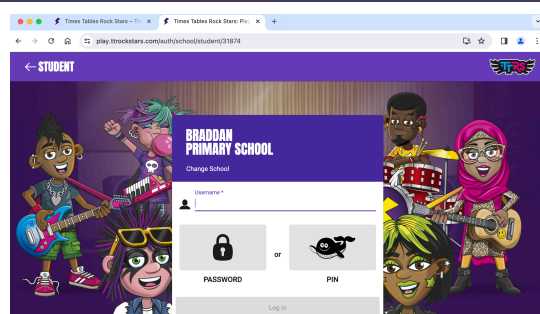
