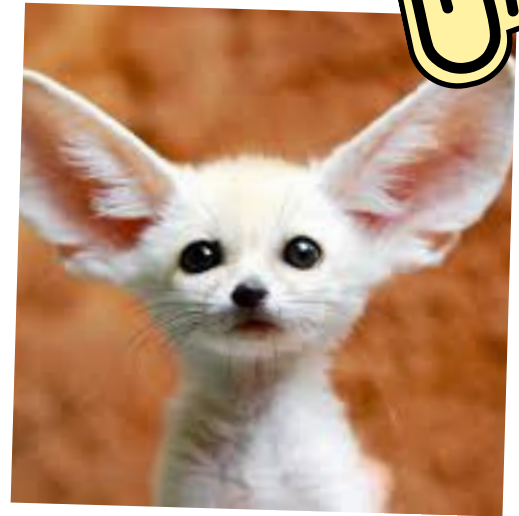


Orca Class

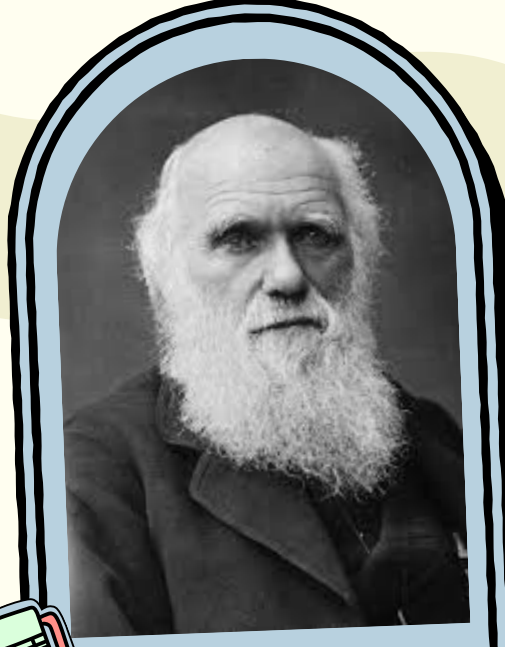
