Phonics, reading and writing

We are learning letter sounds and how to sound out and blend words, e.g. sound out c-a-t and then say cat. We are focusing on writing letters using the correct letter formation. We are also learning to read sight words without sounding them out: I, a, no, go, to, the, etc. We will also share lots of stories and talk about them. We will draw our ideas, sequence pictures and act out ideas.

Talking, listening and thinking

We will talk about ourselves and our feelings. We will use talk to share ideas, take turns, and make up stories when we are playing together. We will have lots of new experiences.

Maths

We will spot 1, 2 and 3 amounts without needing to count! This is called subitising. We will create repeating patterns and sort objects. We will really develop our mathematical vocabulary and we will be doing a lot of thinking and talking. We will ask each other, "What do you notice? What do you see?" We will use positional language, e.g. under, behind, in, on, in front of, next to, between, etc.
