Braddan School Parent Survey Summary

Thank you to the 27 families (over a quarter of our school community) who took the time to complete our recent parent survey. Your feedback is incredibly valuable and helps us identify both our strengths and areas for growth as we plan our school improvement priorities. We are committed to listening, learning, and working together to ensure Braddan School continues to be a place where every child thrives.

1. Areas Where Braddan Is Communicating Well

- Strong alignment with school vision and values: 92% of families understand our mission, Nurturing Potential, Inspiring Futures
- Clear priorities: 74% agree our improvement goals align with our vision
- · Positive relationships and respectful environment: 63% feel the school is very welcoming
- Effective communication methods: Emails, newsletters, texts, and in-person meetings were rated highly
- Children's understanding of their learning: 85% of parents say their child knows their next steps
- Inclusive school culture: Parents praised our nurturing atmosphere, Forest School, and staff's care for children.

2. Areas for Future Development

- Consistency in communication: Some parents noted irregular updates and mentioned a frustration with not knowing staffing in their child's class
- Safeguarding awareness: 37% of families were not aware of our safeguarding policies
- Valuing parental input: Responses were mixed, showing room to improve how we listen and respond
 to parent feedback and how we show the high value we place on parent engagement
- Visibility into children's learning: Parents want more opportunities to see progress during the term
- Parental involvement: Suggestions included more chances to engage in fundraising and community projects

Looking Ahead Together

Braddan School has already begun implementing positive changes based on your feedback. We are launching a Parents' Forum; adjusting our 'Meet the Teacher' format to showcase children's learning; redeveloping our website to ensure it is very informative, and committing to monthly newsletters to improve consistency. The staff at Braddan School are excited to continue building strong partnerships with our families as we work towards our shared mission and vision.
