


It Was A Dark and Stormy Night

Lots of our learning will be inspired by *It Was A Dark and Stormy Night* by Janet and Allen Ahlberg, and *The Land of Roar* by Jenny McLachlan.



These fantastic stories with impressive illustrations are an excellent way to learn about story composition and how stories can adapt. The illustrations will inspire and develop descriptions, and the characters and settings will inspire our Foundation subjects, including Art, Geography, History and Music.

Hazel Class has contributed lots of excellent suggestions on how to develop their learning inspired by these books.

In **English**, our reading will focus on learning and practising skills in the tools for reading to improve fluency, and comprehension to improve understanding and enjoyment of reading. *Please ensure your child reads at home at least three times a week and enters this in their reading journal. Please also send in their reading book and journal daily so that they can be heard individually to develop their fluency skills.*

For **writing**, we will be learning and practising skills in sentence structure and grammar, composition, handwriting and spelling. Our grammar sessions are combined with learning about nature.

Forest School


Thursdays. Please have wellies/old shoes, a spare coat and appropriate clothing for all weathers.


