We are using creativity to inspire our topic this term, using *The Lost Thing* and *The Boy Who Grew Dragons*.

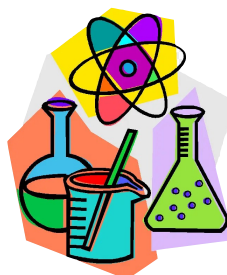
We will be looking at art and artists, particularly sculpture, to consider how objects can be seen in different ways.

Hazel Class has contributed lots of excellent suggestions on how to develop their learning, and we will continue to explore their interests through the term.

In **English**, our reading will focus on learning and practising skills in the tools for reading to improve fluency, and comprehension to improve understanding and enjoyment of reading. *Please ensure your child reads at home at least three times a week and enters this in their reading journal. Please also send in their reading book and journal daily so that they can be heard individually to develop their fluency skills.*

For **writing**, we will be learning and practising skills in sentence structure and grammar, composition, handwriting and spelling. We will be developing our writing skills to create graphic novels.

Science this half term will be Physics - Forces and Magnetism, and Biology - animals, living things and humans. This half term in **Maths** we are focusing on fractions, decimals and money, as well as keeping up with our general calculations skills.
